Boult Family Endowed Innovation Program

“Innovationships” are a groundbreaking scholarship initiative within the Bachelor of Innovation Program at the University of Colorado Colorado Springs (UCCS), designed to foster creativity, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills essential for the modern workforce. This initiative empowers students to develop new ideas and technologies that drive them forward into an innovative mindset in our ever-evolving world. This program will provide financial support, “innovationships,” for students in the Bachelor of Innovation Program as they develop and advance their innovation projects related to their degree programs. Students must submit a 3–5-minute video outlining their impact goals and how the BI will help them achieve that impact. Students will need to track their video’s “social impact” likes and comments and then document that in their personal story in their application. For consideration, students need a 3.0 cumulative GPA. Financial need will be considered. Recipients will be expected to dedicate approximately 50 hours per semester to advance their projects. Recipients are expected to select a faculty, community, or industry mentor for guidance on their project. Minimum award \$5000. Selection Timeline: Students should be notified by July 1st about selection.
